


ALWAYS BETTER TO BE CAUTIOUS!

A week ago, we were excitedly planning to participate in the Community Get Together at Heritage Park in Elmvale on August 22nd. Regretfully, it will not happen. On August 10th I received the following notice from George Allen, the principal organizer. *“Because the ‘covid delta variant’ numbers are rising and we still have a significant unvaccinated population that we can’t identify, and because our children are unvaccinated, I believe it is too risky to go ahead with this event. None of us want to bring harm to the community and people that we love. We could wait and see if the Ontario Government removes restrictions before Aug 22, but that would not reduce the risks. I am sorry about building up expectations and then cancelling the event. However, I love this community too much to take a chance on bringing it harm. George Allen”*

Our EASR group supports George in making this difficult decision. We are anxious to share some of the schematic design plans with you but agree that a mass gathering should be avoided under our current risky conditions. We are currently negotiating for office space in a local building so that we can set up some of our display boards and meet with you personally to explain the the scope of the entire project, the elements that may be included in the first phase and answer some of the questions that you may have. This smaller, more intimate space, may be more conducive to meaningful discussion for you. We will keep you posted about our new office!
